

The latest installment of the Insights on Bridge series contains more carefully crafted mini-lessons designed to turn aspiring players into good players. The material in this book is devoted to situations



This book, carrying on the tradition of Rodwell's Bidding Topics Book 1, contains 9 new bridge topics. As in the first book, each topic starts with the most basic



aspects, then moves to intermediate concepts and at the end, something for experts. This way the material should be of interest to a wide range of players.


Deana rebid 1NT to show her extras, thoughtfully judging this could be the most helpful continuation.

It was all the encouragement Pim needed, and he drove to the spade grand after finding out more about Deana's hand.















After the annoying trump lead she considered her line. The lead meant she could not play the hand on a high crossruff. Instead she planned to make four spades in hand, two hearts, three diamonds. A and three club ruffs. That line needed diamonds to break 4-3, and after that hurdle was overcome. 13 tricks rolled in.

A great sequence for a relatively untried partnership.

Deana – Pim were the only pair in the Mixed Final to reach he spade grand, while it was bid by Tony Nunn - Paul Dalley and Siggy Konig - Justin Mill in the Open Final.
