Early Bird Discount:

To be eligible for the Early Bird Discount your entry must be **paid in full** (both players in Pairs, all players in Teams) no later than **31st March 2023**.

That deadline is approaching fast!

Parking Passes:

Four-day parking passes will be available as usual. Instead of the daily parking cost of \$12, you can purchase a four-day pass for \$24. Please contact Barbara Travis if you would like to organise a parking pass (and please elaborate if you require disabled parking access); passes will be available in advance, or on day 1, but pre-payment is required.

ABF Wellness Policy:

From 1st June 2022, the ABF introduced a Wellness Policy, which addresses illnesses in general, not just Covid-19. All players need to be aware of this policy:

The ABF notes that all state and territory governments no longer require proof of double vaccination and wearing of masks when entering venues and business. As a consequence, these will no longer be mandated for ABF Licensed events. Tournament Organisers will make their own decisions regarding whether or not to relax the earlier policies and players are advised to check the website for each event prior to entry.

Players and officials are asked not to attend any event if they are not well, or if they are supposed to be isolating or quarantining. If you come to play but are not well, you will be asked to leave the venue. If you start feeling unwell with Covid-19 symptoms during any event, please ask the Director to find a substitute until you are feeling well and have a negative RAT.

Tournament Organisers reserve the right to make decisions as to the running and conduct of an ABF Licensed event and vary these regulations to ensure that the health and welfare of the competitors and officials is not compromised.
