East Renee opens 1ヵ, you overcall $2 \star$ and responder passes, partner bids $2 \boldsymbol{\wedge}$.
East now bids $3 \vee$ and you have a tough decision to make. My partner Maurits Van Der Vlugt with a semi balanced hand had an interest in us playing NTs. He was unsure how I would interpret a double and opted to bid 3a.

As the opponent's had bid two suits, I like to play a bid of one of their suits says I have a stopper in the bid suit. I bid 3NT hoping pd and I were on the same wavelength!

My hand was:

- 54

```

Renee cashed her top as and the contract floated 2 down! Not a great result as we were cold for $5 \uparrow$ !
Good Rule: If the opponent's are bidding one suit only a bid of their suit asks for a stopper. If they bid two suits a bid of one of their suits promises a stopper and denies a stopper in the other.
