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Mixed Matchpoint Pairs

Qualifying Friday 19, Saturday 20 January

Final Sunday 21 January

Entries close Wednesday 17 January at 7pm

Eligibility for the NOT quarter final and semi finalists to drop into the Mixed Matchpoint Pairs

To be eligible the players must have a paid entry in the Mixed Matchpoint Pairs

A losing quarterfinalist can drop into Day 2 of the Mixed Matchpoint Pairs with the partner they entered the Mixed Matchpoint Pairs even if that player was not in the NOT.

A losing semi finalist can only drop in as a pair that played at least two sets in the NOT semi final.

7. Make it a golden rule to ALWAYS be kind to your partner.
8. Resist the urge to wish for an early end to an event when things are going well.
9. Abandon the practice of soliciting the entire planet to find someone who agrees with your (clearly mistaken) actions.
10. Keep up the habit of always counting the distributions and points.



My first mistake was passing 5♠ doubled. With such extreme shape I should probably have just bid 6♥ but I didn't, thinking we might be off two aces. So now how do you beat 5♠ doubled?

With my club void I thought (the next mistake!) that I might need to get a club ruff. And surely partner has ♥Q, given he has bid 2♥ and 5♥? Yes, you've guessed it - I tried to be a hero and underled my hearts, allowing the stiff ♥Q to score in dummy! So here we are about to score -650 instead of +980 for making 6♥.

But the story doesn't end there! Declarer lead a trump and partner, who didn't bat an eyelid when ♥Q scored, did just as well by playing low



smoothly and declarer duly played ♠10 losing to my singleton jack! With partner's ♠AK we were back to +100 but definitely not with the three tricks you would expect.....

Unsurprisingly there were several +1210's floating around (6♥ doubled making) so we still lost a fair bit on the board but not nearly as bad as it might have been - and with a much better story!


