Limits as of 30/06/2021 for the masterpoint categories in the Spring Nationals

Category	MP limit	Allowed Systems
Rookie	50	Green only*
Novice	100	Green and blue*
Restricted	300	Green and blue*
Intermediate	750	Green, blue and red

<sup>\*</sup> No brown sticker conventions are allowed. In addition, a pair may be further restricted from playing any method the CTD judges may not be readily understood by a significant proportion of the players in any of the above fields.

All events with masterpoint limits are Gold masterpoints and will be considered for prizes dependent on entries.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Persons applying to enter the Sydney Spring Nationals should be aware of the following:

- The Regulating Authority (The Australian Bridge Federation) reserves the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any registered bridge club, bridge association or the Regulating Authority.
- No entry for an event will be regarded as complete unless the entry has been submitted before the closing date as specified on page 2 of this brochure, with full entry fees paid and ABF numbers supplied. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.
- All players resident in Australia must be current financial members of the ABF Masterpoint Scheme and registered with MyABF.
- Players born on or after 1/1/1996 receive a 50% rebate on their entry fees to all events at the Sydney Spring Nationals.
- 5. All session times in this brochure are provisional and may be altered by the organisers as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the responsibility of players to be aware of the starting times of the sessions and rounds as posted by the Director.
- Systems permitted in the various events are determined in accordance with the ABF Tournament Regulations.
- 7. All players should have working video and audio connections. Players may only turn off their camera with the permission of the Director.
- 8. The Tournament Organiser reserves the right to combine fields in concurrent events if the number of entries in a division is insufficient for a feasible event.
