


## **NORTHERN SUBURBS BRIDGE CLUB**

"Bridge Credits" are the "currency" you can use to pay for your bridge activities when using the MyABF site.

One Bridge Credit equals One Dollar. It is similar to your GoVia account for paying tolls or GoCard account for public transport in that you have the payment option to transfer funds into your MyABF account to conveniently have available when ready to pay an entry fee. Note; this is one payment option and not compulsory. The "MyABF Payment Options" document in Downloads outlines the other Payment Options available to Players on MyABF.



## AUTO TOP UP

You can manually top up the account as required as in the case of a substantial entry fee/s for a congress the likes of the Gold Coast or you can

enable an "AUTO TOP UP" option to automatically transfer a predefined amount when the account balance falls below 20 Bridge Credits i.e. \$20. This will be useful when MyABF moves to club duplicate sessions down the track.


When enabling the AUTO TOP UP you register your credit card (which is totally secure and not saved on the MyABF servers) and then you don't have to worry about topping up the account again.

## The "My Bridge Credits" Payment Option Explained: My Bridge Credits >

If you do not have any Bridge Credits in your MyABF account, you don't have to buy Bridge Credits BEFORE you can enter a congress/es. The Payment Method of "My Bridge Credits" simply means "Use money in my account if I have it otherwise take me to the secure credit card payment screen". This means entrants can go straight to the entry form, complete it, submit it and then pay online. It is just like shopping online.

With some congresses you don't have to pay immediately. By way of example,





- 2. When you are ready to pay, click on the shopping cart and a list of your entries is shown.
- 3. Click on the green button that says "confirm and pay now".

4. You are taken to the secure site where you enter your credit card details and the transaction is finalised.






## Partner's Payment

When a player enters a congress, MyABF provides a number of payment scenarios involving your partner.

- 1. The entrant can pay the total fee for the partnership,
- 2. The entrant can elect to have their partner pay their share i.e. the drop-down box next to your partner's name has the "Ask them to pay" option see image below.



Once this option is selected the entrant will only be paying their share of the entry fee and your partner's share will be seen as Pending - see image below.



- 3. The third option is that Player A can give Player B permission to charge their account directly. This is set-up under Team Mates. Refer to instructions below;
  - Click on your Profile button and click on "Profile"
  - You will see a Team Mates heading
  - In this section click on the green "Add Team Mate" button ADD TEAM MATE to add playing partners
  - Follow the prompts ie \_\_\_\_ and your partner will be added
  - Once added click on the blue "\$" button and it allows your partner to enter you in events using funds in your MyABF account. By clicking on the blue button again you can reverse the action.

This means if Player B creates an entry which includes Player A, they can charge Player A's share directly to their account rather than electing the "Ask them to pay" option. This is very convenient for players as they know if partner is creating an entry, it will also be paid for i.e. "set and forget"!
