14.00	<p>Bridgemates/Compscore3:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• CS3 Best Practices document</li> <li>• When Things Go Wrong. Most common problems encountered: no or insufficient scores imported, problems when changing a movement, deal file incompatibility issues</li> <li>• Bridgemate Management: Fine-tuning. Channels, Setup PIN, quick entry of ARBs, updating BM and server firmware and BCS, compatibility</li> <li>• BM options – scoring program not BCS, BCS log file location and BMPlayerDB, work through Bridgemate settings in CS3</li> <li>• Use of “No Play”, and related CS3 settings</li> <li>• Web site functionality – Bridge Solver, head and umbrella events, Setting up CS3 for different upload hosts e.g. Pianola, bridgeclub.org, Bridgewebs</li> <li>• Deal files – BRIs vs TXTs and PBNs, different ways of importing, souped up anomalies, back-importing, web site exports for BA and XML, PDFs and PBNs, no need to upload deal files any more so sent straight to archive</li> <li>• Opening lead entry and validation, and how to manage things if the deal file is wrong</li> <li>• Handicapping in CS3</li> <li>• Best practice in checking anomalies</li> <li>• Template management</li> <li>• Movement reports, esp. for Howells</li> <li>• Minor CS3 features – timer, slow tables, curtailing a session, median report, set colour</li> <li>• CS3 and MyABF</li> </ul>	Peter Busch
